About Triathlon Queensland

Triathlon Queensland is the state governing body responsible for the strategic development of the sport of triathlon within Queensland. It has 73 affiliated triathlon clubs who are regarded as voting members, as well as administers approximately 5100 individual Triathlon Australia members and 46000 event participants in Queensland.

As an affiliated State and Territory Triathlon Association with Triathlon Australia (a recognized ITU and ASC National Federation), Triathlon Queensland seeks to foster the growth and development of triathlon in Queensland, as well as continuously grow, strengthen and connect the triathlon family and every starting line in Queensland.

The Role of the Board

The Triathlon Queensland Board under Clause 25 of the Triathlon Queensland Constitution is comprised of up to six elected and two appointed directors who collectively have the skills, knowledge, experience and attributes to effectively govern the organization.

It is desirable, but not required for Directors to have an understanding of the Queensland/Australia sport environment and the role and contribution of a State Sporting Organisation and / or an understanding of member-based organisations and the expectations of members, participants, volunteers and clubs.

The Board seeks to be comprised of board members who are diverse in respect of:

- gender;
- age;
- culture; and
- background.

Skillset of the Board

It is expected that Directors will have relevant qualifications and experience in disciplines that are required by the organization, the makeup of this can evolve depending on the needs of the organisation.





Positions on the Board

At the 2020 Annual General Meeting, three (3) interested directors (Lars Olsen, Toni Thornton and Sarah Richmond) will vacate the positions they hold.

Three (3) interested directors (Mark Browne, Paul Azzopardi and Cara Turnley) will remain on the board until the 2021 Annual General Meeting.

At the 2020 Annual General Meeting, the members must elect three (3) interested directors to serve for a period of 2 years ending at the 2021 Annual General Meeting.

Nomination Process

Nominations for interested director positions must be submitted in writing (through the attached nomination form) and received by the Executive Director at least fourteen (14) days prior to the annual general meeting at close of business Monday 5th October 2020.

Whilst it is desirable that nominations should cover these areas of expertise, applications from outside these areas will be considered.

For Interested Directors Positions

A Nominee for election must:

- 1. Submit to the TQ Office a nomination form signed by the nominee and endorsed by the nominating Club by close of business Monday, 5th October 2020.
- 2. Provide information supporting the nominee's election for distribution to and consideration by stakeholders.
